

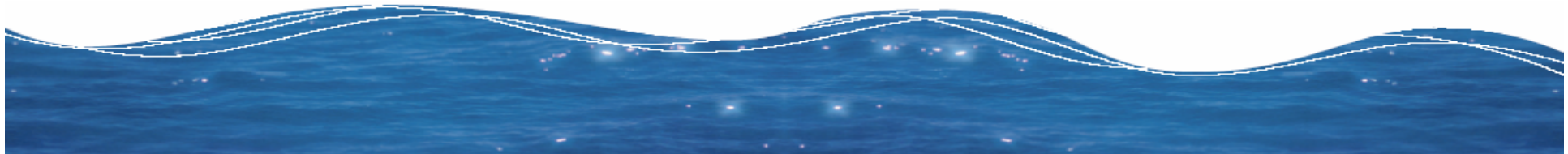

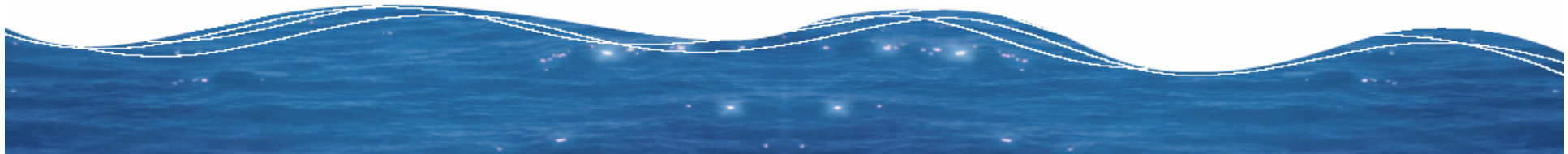

GLOBAL BUSINESS NEEDS GLOBAL RULES

- **INTERNATIONAL CONVENTIONS ARE THE KEY TO GLOBAL GOVERNANCE.**
- **EU'S SHIPPING NATIONS SHOULD BE IN THE CENTER OF THE DECISIONS IN IMO TO KEEP EU'S INFLUENCE IN THE IMO.**
- **A MORE ACTIVE ROLE IN THE RATIFICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF IMO CONVENTIONS WITHIN AND OUTSIDE EU TO STRENGTHENING THE GLOBAL REGIME.**



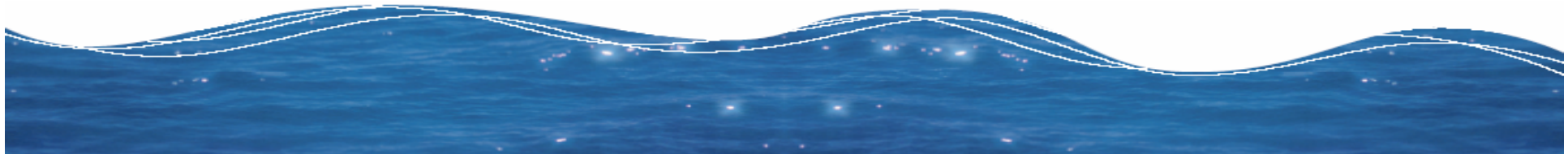


UNCLOS

- **REPRESENTS A WELL BALANCED GLOBAL AGREEMENT – DON'T FIX WHAT IS NOT BROKEN.**

MARKET ACCESS

- **EU SHOULD STRONGLY SUPPORT A COMPREHENSIVE TRADE AGREEMENT IN WTO.**
- **EU'S BILATERAL AGREEMENT IS SUPPORTED BUT SHOULD NOT TAKE AWAY MOMENTUM FROM WTO.**





COMMON EUROPEAN MARITIME SPACE – A OPPORTUNITY

- **AMBITIOUS AGENDA TO REMOVE RED TAPE TO MAKE SHIPPING EVEN MORE EFFICIENT.**
- **ANY PROTECTIONIST MEASURE SHOULD BE AVOIDED DUE TO INTERNATIONAL AND INTERNAL EU PROBLEMS.**
